Nominations by Petition

For a nomination by petition, the petition must be signed by at least 20 members or 1% of the membership, whichever is greater. Nominations shall be accompanied by a certificate from the nominee or nominees stating that they are agreeable to nomination and will serve if elected to office. Each nominee by petition must also submit a statement of qualifications and biographical data.
